The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Jolin

Members present: Bohnsack, Comstock, Dorey, Dunbar and Mayor Jolin
The clerk offered the prayer and the pledge.

Dunbar made a motion to approve the minutes from the Sept 1st meeting. Bohnsack supported the motion. The motion passed all voting aye.

A motion was made by Bohnsack and supported by Comstock to approve the bills for September. The motion passed all voting aye.

Dorey made a motion to approve the agenda. The motion was supported by Bohnsack. The motion passed all voting aye.

Abandon Lindbergh Right of Way

This item was tabled at the September 1st meeting. A motion was made by Bohnsack to take from the table the issue of the abandonment of Lindbergh from Edison to Bridgeview South. The motion was supported by Dunbar. The motion passed all voting aye.

The clerk read a resolution to vacate a portion of Lindbergh St. from Edison to the northern edge of Grandview Gardens. A motion was made by Dorey and supported by Comstock to adopt the resolution. The motion passed all voting aye.

Tennis & Basketball Court Repairs

This item was tabled at the September 1st meeting. Comstock made a motion to take from the table the issue of repairing the basketball courts and two tennis courts. The motion was seconded by Bohnsack. The motion passed.

The DPW Superintendant Davis received a cost of \$2,150.00 from Mr. Asphalt to repair the basketball courts and two tennis courts. A motion was made by Bohnsack and supported by Dorey to approve the repair of the courts at a cost of \$2,150.00. The motion passed 3-2. Comstock and Dunbar voting no. Bohnsack, Dorey and Mayor Jolin voting aye

Parks and Recreation Board.

The chairman of the Parks and Recreation Board asks that the board be reduced from 9 members to 7 members so that they can conduct business as they are having a difficult time getting a quorum with 9 members. A motion was made by Comstock and supported by Bohnsack to reduce the board to 7 members. The motion passed all voting aye.

Zoning Board of Appeals

The term of Bert Rivette expires in November. He has agreed to serve if reappointed. Dorey made a motion to reappoint Bert Rivette to the Zoning Board of Appeals with the term expiring 11/30/2012. The motion was supported by Dunbar. The motion passed.

A motion was made by Comstock and supported by Bohnsack to adjourn. The motion passed all voting aye.
