**City Pump House Transfer**

The City owns the pump house and .11 acres of property at the Zilwaukee School. This property is inside the school's remodeling project. The clerk read a letter from the Saginaw School District requesting transfer of the property from the City to The Saginaw School District. The clerk then read a resolution to transfer the pump house and property to the Saginaw School District. Bohnsack made a motion to adopt the resolution. Dorey supported the motion. The motion passed all voting aye.
